

FLORIDA TRIP PARENT'S INFO

1. Please review with your child the rules pertaining to school and band program. Disney Parks expect a high level of behavior from their performers. Please stress this with your child.
2. Please make sure you complete the new **Emergency Medical Form** and return it tonight.
3. **Any prescriptions or medical conditions must be noted on the EMERGENCY MEDICAL FORM. All medications must be given to the nurse on Wednesday March 12 from 6-8 PM** All medicines must be in their **original bottles with the prescription printed** on the label. **No student should have medicine (including over the counter medicines) , other than inhalers or bee stings kits in their possession.** Mrs. Wehry/Gopp will be dispensing all medications. If any information changes prior to leaving, you should complete an **EMF update form**. These will be available on the 14th.
4. We recommend using travelers checks for the majority of the money on the trip. Encourage your child to ration the money and only carry enough for one day.
5. We are counting on you to check the materials your child brings on the trip. This includes movies. G, PG or PG 13 please.
6. **Double check** to make sure that your child has the band uniform with **Polished Black Shoes** (no tennis shoes), **Black Socks, Clean Spats, and Clean Gloves.** **DON'T FORGET THE CAPE or CORDS and Band T-SHIRT.**
7. Any students who are not returning with the band must complete the **STUDENTS WHO WILL NOT BE RETURNING HOME WITH THE BAND** form and return it to Mr. Monroe by the packing night. Please follow all direction included with the form.
8. If you are down in Florida and want to spend time with your child we have a few items:
 - * Parents may not attend the "Your Instrumental" Workshop. Also, parents may not be "backstage" with the band students before or after the parade.
 - * **You are welcome to spend time with your child during the trip, however, if you wish to take your child anywhere else or leave a park, you will be signing him/her out for the remainder of the trip.**
 - * Students must travel to and from the parks on our busses. Attendance will be taken.
 - * Please do not deviate from our schedule while in the parks. We need all student be present at all check-in times.
 - * Students must be in their rooms by lights out.
