

Kimpton Night Schedule

Parents and Students,

As you know, the first performance for both Kimpton bands will be with the high school band during the Kimpton Band Night performance. This performance will be at the **September 23rd** Homecoming parade and home football game. Remember, rehearsals for this performance will be Thursday, September 15 from 6-7 and September 22 from 6-7 at the high school. Percussion students should plan on arriving at 5:00 PM for both rehearsals. **These rehearsals and performance are mandatory for ALL students.** Students will need to purchase a Stow Band T-Shirt at one of these rehearsals (unless you already own a t-shirt). The T-Shirts will be available for purchase in the choir room between 7 and 7:30 after both rehearsals. Remember to purchase a shirt that is large enough to wear layers underneath. The cost of shirts is as follows: tuba \$11, percussion \$10 all others \$8. **The complete uniform for this performance is the Stow Band t-shirt and blue jeans and tennis shoes.**

STUDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR AND MUST BRING THEIR MUSIC, STICKS/MALLETS, LYRE AND INSTRUMENT. THE DIRECTORS WILL TRANSPORT: PERCUSSION, TUBAS, BARITONES, TENOR SAX AND MELLOPHONES.

5:45 dinner – hot dogs supper provided by *Band Parents

7:00 line up on the practice field for inspection and march to the stadium

7:15 performance

ALL STUDENTS WILL BE DISMISSED AT HALFTIME! (Approximately 8:30 PM)

Students may be picked up at the front of the high school, ticket booth by their parents or stay for the rest of the game with their parents. The high school will be locked 3rd and 4th quarters and not accessible by students. Students and parents must have a plan in place prior to the game regarding pick up time and location.
