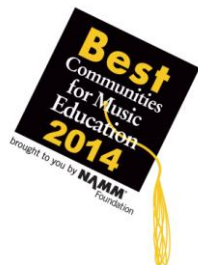
On behalf of the Stow-Munroe Falls School District and the Stow Band Parents Association, welcome to our Marching Band Show.
