Don Ricardo is a paso doble written in the Spanish tradition. It is dedicated to Mr. Richard Crain for his selfless devotion to the students of the Spring Independent School District, Houston, Texas. In 1979, Mr. Crain moved to Houston to become the band director at Spring High School. In 1982, he became Director of Music for the Spring Independent School District over all levels of band, choir, elementary and drill teams. During the next 18 years under his leadership, Spring ISD became known as one of the foremost districts in the nation for music education. Bands under his baton garnered awards and honors both in the state of Texas as well as attaining national acclaim at festivals, contests, and conventions.

Cycle of the Werewolf.....Jeremy S. Martin

Cycle of the Werewolf was inspired by the Stephen King short story of the same name. The story was published in 1983 by Land of Enchantment and again by Signet in 1985. The story was adapted in 1985 to become a film entitled Silver Bullet, starring Corey Haim and Gary Busey. A dark portrayal of the Werewolf's character begins the composition. It shifts briefly to a major tonality later as the hero successfully fights the werewolf and back to minor as the monster howls into the night. After a slight pause, the music lingers as the hero awaits the werewolf's eventual return and ends climactically with the defeat of the creature.

MUSIC FROM JURASSIC PARK Based on the book by Michael Crichton, the movie Jurassic Park tells the story of a theme park that suffers a major power breakdown during a preview tour, allowing its cloned dinosaur exhibits to run amok. This piece opens with the suggestion of approaching dinosaur footsteps, and their accompanying doom. Three major melodic ideas can be heard in this score. The "Theme from Jurassic Park" is introduced when the visitors first see the Brachiosaurus, and conveys the elegance and beauty of the dinosaurs. A noble

fanfare is heard as the helicopter approaches Isla Nublar. The third major theme is comprised of four menacing notes, and is heard frequently in scenes involving the threat of the carnivorous dinosaurs.

One of the most popular and successful American orchestral composers of the modern age, John Williams is the winner of five Academy Awards, 17 Grammys, three Golden Globes, two Emmys and five BAFTA Awards from the British Academy of Film and Television Arts. Best known for his film scores and ceremonial music, Williams is also a noted composer of concert works and a renowned conductor. Williams' scores for such films as Jaws, E.T.: The Extra-Terrestrial, Schindler's List, as well as the Indiana Jones series, have won him multiple awards and produced best-selling recordings, and his scores for the original Star Wars trilogy transformed the landscape of Hollywood film music and became icons of American culture.

American Elegy.....Frank Tichelli

An American Elegy is, above all, an expression of hope. It was composed in memory of those who lost their lives at Columbine High School on April 20, 1999, and to honor the survivors. It is offered as a tribute to their great strength and courage in the face of a terrible tragedy. I hope the work can also serve as one reminder of how fragile and precious life is and how intimately connected we all are as human beings.

I was moved and honored by this commission invitation, and deeply inspired by the circumstances surrounding it. Rarely has a work revealed itself to me with such powerful speed and clarity. The first eight bars of the main melody came to me fully formed in a dream. Virtually every element of the work was discovered within the span of about two weeks. The remainder of my time was spent refining, developing, and orchestrating.

The work begins at the bottom of the ensemble's register, and ascends gradually to a heartfelt cry of hope. The main theme that follows, stated by the horns, reveals a more lyrical, serene side of the piece. A second theme, based on a simple repeated harmonic pattern, suggests yet another, more poignant mood. These three moods - hope, serenity, and sadness - become intertwined throughout the work, defining its complex expressive character. A four-part canon builds to a climactic quotation of the Columbine *Alma Mater*. The music recedes, and an offstage trumpeter is heard, suggesting a celestial voice - a heavenly message. The full ensemble returns with a final, exalted statement of the main theme.

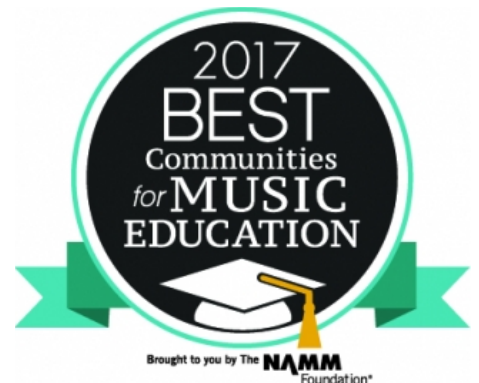
